

ABATE monthly meeting
September 13, 2010
Minutes

Dan called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m.

Officer reports:

Bob moved that we dispense with the reading of the minutes from the August meeting and approve them as written. Roland seconded. Motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

President: Dan had two issues to cover in the meeting: Coach fees and buying/selling motorcycles from the rider courses. Bob stated that he would like to sell the three red Enduros and the two oldest Rebels. The Rebel sales would be on the condition that two new Rebels would be purchased. Roland moved that a grant be submitted for new bikes, and if approved ABATE would buy 2 new Rebels. Pam seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Bob moved that ABATE sell the three red Enduros, and as long as a grant is approved to buy two new Rebels, sell the two oldest Rebels. Pam seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote. The bikes will be sold "as is".

Bob moved that the coach fee be increased by \$25.00 for those classes where there is a range assistant working and the ERC coach fee be increased to \$100.00 retro to the start of the 2010 season. Floid seconded the motion. The motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Old Business: Dan reported the Buoy Deck is reserved for December 11 for the ABATE Holiday party.

New Business: Bob moved that the dues for Ben be waived for this year for his help in the class and on the range. Pam proposed revising the motion to waive the rest of this year and the 2011 dues. Bob seconded the revised motion. The revised motion carried by unanimous voice vote.

Good of the Order: Bob advised that there would be a bike winterization and maintenance event the 1st Saturday in October (October 2) at 9:30 a.m. Don will provide a generator, Bob will supply a pressure washer, and Larry will be asked about having water available.

Dan announced the Toy Run is next Sunday (September 19). Riders will meet at Donna's restaurant at 12:00 noon, and the ride will begin at 1:00 p.m. Riders are to bring a stuffed toy costing \$10.00 or more.
